The AIA Hampton Roads Chapter has established a scholarship of \$1,500 for a high school senior who has been accepted into an institute of higher learning pursuing a degree in architecture, planning, or historic preservation. The award payment will be disbursed in August 2019.

Candidates must have a cumulative 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) or higher and possess one of the following:

- 1. A letter of enrollment from their high school guidance counselor verifying that he/she has been accepted in an institution of higher learning and will enroll in the upcoming fall classes
- 2. An official "Letter of Acceptance" from the institute's Registrar
- 3. A copy of a college admission letter for upcoming Fall enrollment

We are asking for applicants to submit a 400-500 word essay detailing how a building or place in Hampton Roads has helped to inspire their choice to pursue a career in architecture, planning, or historic preservation. All essays shall be typed and submitted in PDF format as an email attachment. Submissions are due by 11:59 EST on Monday, April 1, 2019.
