#### All student evaluations will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- 1. Reside in Virginia Beach and attend a Virginia Beach Public School.
- 2. Scholastic Achievement
  - A minimum 3.0 GPA is required.
  - A sealed official high school transcript must be submitted with the application.
- 3. Letters of Recommendation
  - Two letters of recommendation from individuals with personal knowledge of the applicant's abilities must accompany the scholarship application.
  - One of the two recommendation letters must be from a high school teacher or counselor. Letters from relatives are NOT acceptable.
- 4. Typed essay (200 words minimum; double spaced) describing the following:
  - Why have you decided to attend a Historically Black College & University?
- 5. Interview
  - A video answering the following questions . Please email video to Igoscholars@gmail.com
    - What is your impression of an HBCU versus a non-HBCU?
    - What do you think you will gain from attending an HBCU?
    - o Which HBCU are you most interested in?
    - o How will you get involved in your university?
    - What colleges have you applied to? Where have you been accepted and what are your top three?
    - Why should the scholarship committee award you the Anna Jordan Brinkley Scholarship?
