#### **ERIC'S BIOGRAPHY**

The Eric Sorg Memorial Scholarship, established in 2012, honors Eric James Sorg, aka "BIG CAT."

Eric passed away Aug. 21, 2011 of injuries he sustained in a fall while exploring a mountain trail in Patrick County, VA. He died the way he lived, curious about what was around the bend and ready for an adventure. Eric was 17 and ready to begin his senior year at First Colonial (FC) High School. The world was his for the taking . . . as is YOURS.

Eric was born September 12, 1993 at Fort Belvoir, VA, to Col. James H. "Jay" and Nancy Sorg. He had an older sister, Camryn. He lived in Quantico, VA; on Camp Lejeune Marine Corps Base, NC; Virginia Beach, VA; and Japan before returning to Virginia Beach in 2007. At FC Eric played



on the varsity volleyball team, was a member of the National Honor Society, and participated in other school activities. Eric also was a former soccer player for Virginia Rush and for FC. He worked for the Scott Rigell congressional campaign and part-time at Cold Stone Creamery . Volunteering at the Virginia Beach City Schools Ropes Course, TOPSoccer, and the JCOC Soup Kitchen, as well as with other organizations gave Eric much pleasure. In addition to being an artist and enjoying all types of music, he loved skateboarding and other outdoor activities. While Eric had boundless energy, he also was kind-hearted. His thoughtfulness extended beyond the love of his rescue dog, Daisy, and loyalty to his friends -- when applying for his drivers license, Eric chose, without hesitation, to be an organ donor ,because of his desire to potentially ease the suffering of others.

After Eric's death, his friends and family created a WORDLE using words or phrases that exemplified Eric's character, personality and spirit. It evocatively demonstrates in a visual way who Eric was and will serve as the framework for the ideals on which this scholarship is based.



#### **Purpose:**

The Eric Sorg Memorial Scholarshop was created by the Sorg Family to:

- Preserve the memory of Eric James Sorg, aka "Big Cat"
- Allow friends, neighbors and family to make contributions in his name to honor him
- Give back to the Virginia Beach community where the Sorg family was proud to raise their son

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

Applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior at First Colonial High School
- Be accepted into a program of study at a post-secondary educational institution, as evidenced by a letter of acceptance and a letter of deposit.
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 at the time of application

### Method of Selection:

The recipient of the scholarship will be selected on the basis of academic achievement, as well as participation in school and community activities and organizations. More importantly, the recipient will have a commitment to the ideals on which the scholarship is based. The selection will be made by the Sorg Family and a committee of their choice.

### **Application Process:**

- Application period open through May 24, 2019.
- Applications must be received via hard copy by the First Colonial HS Guidance Office by the close of business day on May 24, 2019 or electronically by midnight on May 24, 2019. Email to: Adrienne.Tomao@vbschools.com
- Application review and selection of a recipient to be completed by May 29, 2019.
- Selection notification will be made to First Colonial High School the following week.
- The scholarship will be awarded at FC's Senior Awards Ceremony.

### Amount of the Award:

A \$2500 Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Senior at First Colonial High School.

### Checklist:

This application and attached essays, along with an official copy of the applicant's high school transcript, two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers or community members, acceptance letter from the intended college or university and proof of deposit must be received by the designated date. Late applications will not be considered.
